Rates of license fees for F.L-IV Licenses where the membership is restricted to anyone class/ category of member shall be 25% of the licence fee payable by the F.L-IV Licenses. However, eligibility of the club for this concession shall be certified annually by the Commissioner of State Excise, Maharashtra State, Mumbai.

Notwithstanding anything contained above, the rate of license fees applicable to cantonment area shall be the same as applicable to the Municipal / Corporation area within whose boundaries such cantonment is located within or which are adjacent to the limits of such Municipal/ Corporation.

These rates of Licence fees are not applicable to the existing licences which have been renewed for the period of five years prior to the financial year 2016-2017 during the period of their validity.
